

Our Missionary to Uganda: Muhindo Kawede



In December of 1977, Muhindo Kawede realized that he was a sinner who needed to repent and accept Jesus' gift of salvation. Previously, Muhindo's life was characterized by witchcraft and evil, but when Christ entered his life, he surrendered his way of life and began evangelizing in the villages and market places of the

Democratic Republic of the Congo. He enrolled and graduated from the Baptist Bible Institute and served as an associate pastor in a local church for five years before fleeing the Congo due to war and violence. He and his family settled in Kampala, Uganda where he now serves as the chief administrator for In-Touch Mission International's College of Missions. The college trains and equips pastors, evangelists, and teachers in order give them the foundation to "correctly handle the word of truth (2 Tim 3:17). Please pray for Muhindo and his family.
